**The Resolutions and Legislation Committee** Chairperson, Adele Bezaire, has prepared a petition to be sent to The Legislative Assembly of Ontario. The petition asks that they "cease providing taxpayers' dollars for the performance of abortions by passing legislation to remove abortion as a service covered by the Ontario Health Insurance Plan".

It costs **Ontario** taxpayers over **30 million dollars a year for abortions** – over 80 million for Canada.

**Did you know** that abortions are fully paid for with few questions asked, little information provided, no waiting period, easy and quick to obtain?

Abortion is not a necessity – only a choice.

**Did you know** that under Canada's employment insurance guidelines, women who have abortions after 19 weeks of gestation can apply for 17 weeks maternity leave?
